Remembering Martin Luther King Junior

(1929-1968)



Each January, the United States remembers slain civil rights leader **Martin Luther King Jr.**

King worked during his life to end racial segregation by using forms of nonviolent or peaceful resistance. He is perhaps best known for his famous 'I Have a Dream' speech, which was given on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington D.C. in 1963.

King also fought against poverty and sought to bring an end to the Vietnam War.

Every January, to coincide with the anniversary of King's birth, January 15th, the United States celebrates **Martin Luther King Jr. Day**.

MLK Day is held on the third Monday of January each year, and this year it will be celebrated on January 17th.

~READING~

Being able to read is essential for our students. Presently we are looking for ideas to help our students improve their reading skills. Below is Raymer's current reading data.

Grades K-3: 58% of our students are on a **R**eading Improvement **M**onitoring **P**lan (RIMP). This means that 107 students out of 186 students are not at grade level for reading and will probably not pass the state third grade reading test when in third grade. If students do not pass this test they are not promoted to fourth grade (state law).

Grades 3-8: 2021 Spring ELA State Test – 36 students out of 239 students (15%) passed the state ELA (reading & writing) test.
