

### INTERNET DANGERS

Did you know that 725,000 kids have been brutally asked for sex, nudes, and to meet without telling their parents? This is why kids should be careful on the internet because not only are kids getting sexually harassed but they are also getting bullied for what they post. For example, if someone posts a picture of them in a bathing suit they can get called fat or they could get told they need to eat more.

Kids should watch who they talk to on the internet because they have never met them personally. It states more than 40,000 predators are online at any moment. That means that your child could be a victim and you wouldn't even know it. Also, 77% of victims that talk to predators are 14 or older. So, there is a 50/50 percent chance your child is talking to a predator online. You never know who your child is talking to online whether it is a predator or not.

Cyberbullying is also very common on the internet and it makes children very sad. 12% of kids have been bullied online for what they post and only 6% of the parents know. Even if it is a picture, something you said, or a tik tok of you dancing, people are always going to be hating or spreading rude rumors. There is a percentage of 65 kids who have been victims of cyberbullying that were the ages 14 years or older. There have been a lot of suicides, people gaining depression, and kids hurting themselves because of cyberbullying. Parents need to check on their kids and find out if they are being bullied.

Some people say, "My kids are smart and know when they are talking to predators." They also say, "If my child was being bullied online then they would tell me." Well actually, little kids like 6-8 years of age can be easily tricked into doing what the predators ask for. If kids are being bullied online they would be scared to tell people because they don't like when people ask them questions. They are also scared they would get in trouble for not doing anything about it.

Therefore, kids should be careful on the internet because they never know what they can get into. Teens get bullied all the time for what they post. There are a lot of predators online and active every day.
