THIRD GRADE READING GUARANTEE (TGRG)



What is TGRG?

TGRG is a program that ensures that every struggling reader in grades K-3 gets the support he/she needs to be able to learn and achieve.

How does TGRG work?

In Grades K-3 schools evaluate all students to determine if they are reading as well as they should be. TPS uses the iREADY Diagnostic Assessment. Results come back as “on-track” OR “not on-track.” Students testing “not on-track” are placed on a **RIMP** (Reading Improvement and Monitoring Plan).

What is a RIMP?

RIMP is a plan to get student’s reading skills “on-track” so that he/she will be a successful reader. A RIMP is created and implemented by the classroom teacher.

Promotion to Fourth Grade

Third grade students must pass Ohio State’s English Language Arts Test to be promoted to the Fourth Grade. This test will be given two times during the third grade year. Summer school will be offered to students who do not pass and students will have the opportunity during summer school to retake the test.

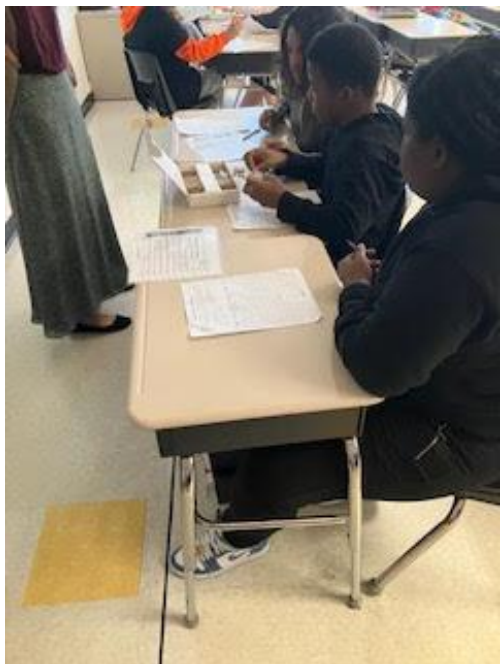
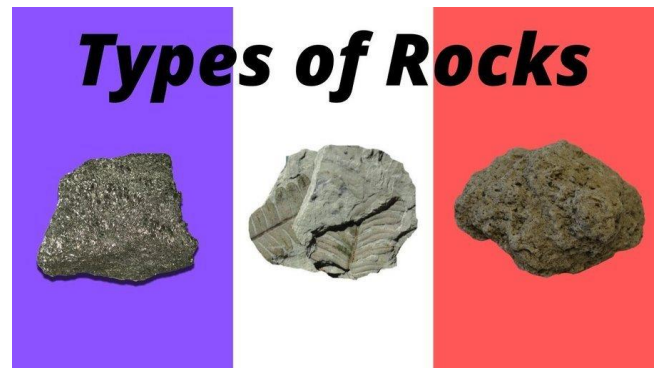

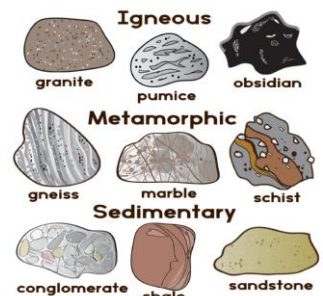
