


RAYMER'S VISION

(1929-1968)




Each January, the United States remembers slain civil rights leader **Martin Luther King Jr.**

King worked during his life to end racial segregation by using forms of nonviolent or peaceful resistance. He is perhaps best known for his famous 'I Have a Dream' speech, which was given on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington D.C. in 1963.

King also fought against poverty and sought to end the Vietnam War. Every January, to coincide with the anniversary of King's birth, January 15, the United States celebrates Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

MLK Day is held on the third Monday of January each year, and this year it will be celebrated on January 16th.
