### **May 24 – FIELD DAY – Bounce Houses!**

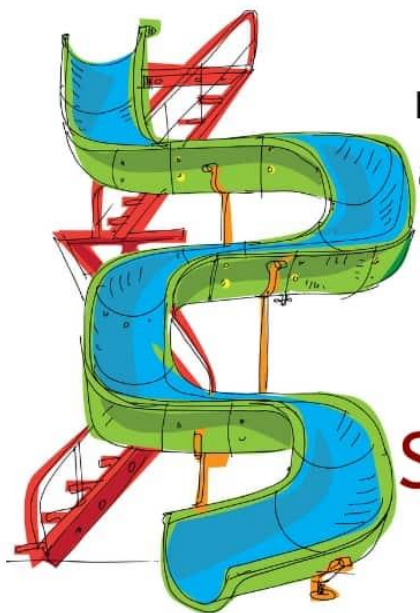
