

Attendance and House Bill 410

House Bill 410 – The state of Ohio has changed the law regarding attendance. The definition of habitual truant has changed from day to hours absent. The threshold is now 30 or more consecutive hours, 42 or more hours in one month or 72 or more hours in one school year without legitimate excuse. Schools are required to complete an **Absence Intervention Plan** (AIP) with the parents and student to help improve attendance.

If attendance does not improve after the development of the plan, TPS will file a complaint in Juvenile Court.

VISITORS

Parents and guardians are always welcome at Raymer. All visitors, parents, and volunteers are required to report to the office before proceeding to their destination. Guests will be issued a "Visitor's Pass." Visits to classes during class time for the purpose of conferring with the teacher, will require administrative approval and are generally discouraged.



CHANGE OF CONTACT?

If you have **moved** or **changed your telephone number**, we ask that you update your records with the school office. This is especially important, as we need up-to-date contact information in the event of an emergency.



If your child's teacher allows water bottles in the classroom, the water must be in a <u>clear container</u>.

"Parent's Right to Know"

As a parent/guardian with a student attending a Toledo Public School that receives Title I funds, you have the right to know the qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. The federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act requires that any local school district receiving Title I funds must provide the following information to parents/guardians who ask about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher:

- Whether the teacher has met the Ohio teacher licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides your child instruction.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or temporary status that waives state licensing requirements.
- The undergraduate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate degree or certification (such as National Board Certification) held by the teacher and the field of discipline of certification or degree.
- Whether your child is provided services by instructional paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

All requests must be made in writing and should include the following information: student's full name, legal parent/guardian's full name, address, city, state, zip code and teacher's name. Your request can be sent to the Toledo Board of Education, Human Resources Department, 1609 Summit Street, Toledo, OH 43604.
